

## Morning of the Exam:

1. Bring your NCEES “exam day” information and admission notice to the exam (this will be available a few weeks before the exam on the NCEES website).
2. Bring your photo ID (check the Exam Day Policies for appropriate ID).
3. Bring your Approved Calculator.
4. Turn your phone off and leave it in your car. Your phone isn’t allowed in the exam room and it will be one less thing you need to worry about.
5. Bring ear plugs.
6. Wear something comfortable and dress in layers. Bring a light sweater.
7. Know where you’re going. Get to the exam site early, find a quiet area, and review your notes. Resist the urge to talk with others, unless you think this will relieve some stress.
8. Be prepared for an hour or more after the doors to the exam site open before taking the first 4-hour test. There will be a lot of paperwork to fill out and rules the proctors will read to you.
9. Bring ALL of your references.
10. Bring a packable, bag lunch. There will likely be no food at the exam.
